

User Manual TIMERS TA030 and TA040

- 1. When the voltage is applied, on the main screen (1) will appers STOP and on the screen nr 2 the last set time. The clock allows to set up 10 programs in the memory.
- 2. To change the time press for 3 seconds the START button. At first step choose the program to change (1 to 10). After moving the cursor to the appropriate program press START button.
- 3. On the main screen, at the hours position, will flash: »02«.05. By cursors ↑ (up) and ↓ (down) set the required number of hours. Next press for a moment the START button, at the minutes position will flash: 02.»05«.


By cursors \uparrow (up) and \downarrow (down) set the required number of minutes, then confirm the value by pressing START button. The set time will be automatically saved in the memory.

- 4. To run the machine press START button. Then the red LED (3) will flash between hours and minutes 02».«05.
- 5. To correct the set time, during the work, press STOP button the machine will stop correct the time in the same way as in point 2 and 3.
- 6. To stop the machine for a moment press START button, to run the machine also press START button.
- 7. Pressing STOP button during the work will stop the machine and also restart the set time. The operation may be performed many times during the work.
- 8. After the set time end the main screen will show STOP.
- 9. In case of power failure the machine will stop. When the machine power is restored the clock will start automatically and count down the remaining time.
- 10. When the machine is equipped with an inverter the 2 errors may apper:

ER1 - clock error

ER2 – inverter error

In both cases the machine must be disconnect from the power. Then the error should be removed and the machine could start again.
